4. Official Venue of Arrival and Departure

The official arrival and departure venue for officials, referees and participating teams is Billund Airport, which is located 40 km from the competition venue. 11. Meals

The food comprises 3 meals, breakfast, lunch and dinner, starting with dinner on arrival day. Breakfast will be served at the hotels. Lunch and dinner will be served in the sports hall. Time schedule for the meals will be determined according to the match schedule.

Each team can preorder a snack for each competition day for the price of 3 euro per snack per person. Use the attached **Registration Form** and send it to the organizer at the latest the 16th of November

During the matches and training sessions tap water will be available. Teams should bring their own bottles for tap water.

Please let us know at the latest 16th of November if you have any special dietary requirements (e.g. vegetarians, food allergies etc.)



12. Laundry

Laundry of the sport uniforms will be available at the sports hall.

13. Medical Services

The event is subject to CEV anti-doping regulations.

Covid-19:

Preferable is that all participants are fully vaccinated. If not, we would ask all not fully vaccinated persons, to bring proof of a negative pcr-test, not more than 72 hours old upon arrival at the airport.

Please also notice that you might will have to be tested upon arrival at the airport.

It is the responsibility of each visiting team to keep you informed about the rules and restrictions for travelling.

14. Preliminary Inquiry

Please notice that this tournament will use the CEV WCM-system.

The Preliminary Inquiries for each team will be carried out on Thursday 16th of December, according to time of arrival.

The exact times will be announced in Bulletin no. 2.

The following items are to be controlled:

- Final team/player participation (05bis form)
- Passport or identity card of each player
- Inspection of players uniform (to determine uniform colours in each match)
- Financial Matters

PLEASE NOTE:

Deadlines for registration in the CEV WCM system

- 04 (License): 17th of November. Notice that if a player is not registered on the 04-form, this player can not play in the tournament
- 05 (players long list): Not yet announced, but most likely 14 days before the first match
- 05-bis (12 players and official staff): 16th of December

15. Referees

Each team should bring a referee. If not, a fee of 500 euro should be paid to the organizer

16. Match Ball

The official ball of the tournament is the MIKASA MVA 200.

17. National Anthems and Flags

The National Anthems and flags of each team will be presented before each game. Team Managers are asked to check with the sound technician on arrival at the venue for the first game that the correct version is being used.



18. Financial Matters

The contribution fee amounts 70 € per person per day for each participating player, support staff and officials = 280,- euro. All participating countries should pay for all official days, even if arrival is late and/or departure is early.

The contribution fee for each delegation, including preordered snack, eventually missing referee and the cost for airport transport, shall be paid by bank transfer to the bank account of Volleyball Denmark (see details below). Such transactions must be completed no later than the 14th of December 2021. All transaction costs are at the senders' expense. No other methods of payment will be accepted. A receipt shall be presented at the preliminary inquiry.

19. Composition of Delegations

Participating teams are permitted to have a team delegation composed of a maximum of 17 members:

- 12 players
- Team officials:
 - 1 Team Manager
 - 1 Coach
 - 2 other staff
 - 1 Referee

Referees should be of highest level in each country.

Countries which do not bring a referee for each representative team, will pay 500 EUR to the organizer for their non-attending referee.

Only team delegation members (the players and staff members listed in the 05-bis) can enter the competition area during a match. Team Manager are allowed on the bench.

20. Meeting rooms

Meeting rooms will be available at the sports hall and in some extend at the hotels.



21. Video

There is a possibility for the installation of a team video camera for teams with the agreement of the organizer.

The exact place for team video cameras will be informed at the preliminary inquiry.

22. Additional Requirements

All persons requiring VISA's must have this in place prior to the competition.

23. Inquiries and Further Information

Age group: players participating in category U18 shall be aged 17 years or younger during the whole year when the tournament will take place. Therefore, players must be born 1st of January 2005 or thereafter.

The winner of the final will go directly to the Final round in Georgia the 9th – 17th of July 2022. The looser of the final will qualify for the 2nd round, played the 21st- 24th of April 2022.

Allocation of points as follows:

- 3 points for the winner 3:0 or 3:1 of a match
- 2 points for the winner 3:2 of a match
- 1 point for the loser 2:3 of a match
- 0 points for the loser 0:3 or 1:3 of a match

There is a tie between participants when each participant has the same number of matches won. In case of a tie, the standing of the participants is established by using the following criteria in the following mentioned order, until the tie ends:

1. in descending order by the number of allocated points for won and lost matches
2. in descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of all sets won by all sets lost during the CEV competition
3. in descending order by the sets points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by all set points lost during the CEV competition
4. in descending order by the result(s) of the match(es) played between them.

In case there is a protest it must be done in line with the CEV regulations and procedures.

Playing protocol

- Warm up 1 hour before start
- Toss 18 minutes before start
- Warm up 2x5 min. at net + serve 17 minutes to start
- National anthems 4 minutes to start
- Handing over pins etc.
- Starting players sitting on the bench
- Presentation referees 2 minutes to start
- Presentation starting 7 players + HC 1 minute to start

If the match before is delayed, you will have, altogether, 32 minutes before next match starts
