8. Participating teams

2022 CEV U-17 Volleyball European Championship is open to the National Teams of those National Volleyball Federations that are affiliated to the FIVB and CEV and respect their obligations and financial responsibilities to the FIVB and CEV and respect these regulations.

The players must have the nationality of the country they represent, justifying it using a passport or other authentic document.

The players must present their passport or ID cards issued by a national government authority.

Naturalized players must have been proven resident in the country of their new nationality for not less than two years (up to the opening day of the Tournament) from the date of issue of the official document granting the new citizenship.

The following 12 teams are participating in the 2022 CEV U17 Volleyball European Championship Final Round Women:

9. Entries, Team information

By June 14 each Federation will have to complete, exclusively via the CEV online database, **the 05 forms**, thereby listing the composition of the team – selecting the players to be retained among those featured in the 04 form – and providing all other information required there.

<u>The 05bis form</u>, i.e. the Final Team Registration composition, will have to be completed <u>before the start of the</u> <u>Preliminary Inquiry</u> and this task will be also performed only and exclusively via the CEV online database.



10. Competition system

The competition system is according to the CEV Regulations.

The 12 National Federations were drawn in 2 Preliminary pools.

From each Preliminary pool, the 4 best-placed teams will qualify for the Semi-Finals for places 1-4 and 5-8, and the last 2 teams in each pool are eliminated from the tournament.

The Semi-Finals will be played as follows:

- a. (YWF-31) 3rd Pool II vs 4th Pool I,
- b. (YWF-32) 3rd Pool I vs 4th Pool II,
- c. (YWF-33) 1st Pool II vs 2nd Pool I,
- d. (YWF-34) 1st Pool I vs 2nd Pool II.

The classification matches will be played as follows:

a. (YWF-35 for 7th and 8th places) loser of match YWF-31 vs loser of match YWF-32,

- b. (YWF-36 for 5th and 6th places) winner of match YWF-31 vs winner of match YWF-32,
- c. (YWF-37 for 3rd and 4th places) loser of match YWF-33 vs loser of match YWF-34,
- d. (YWF-38 for 1st and 2nd places) winner of match YWF-33 vs winner of match YWF-34.

11. Medical services and Control

All players are obliged to present a Health Certificate – M-3 Form – issued on 16 June 2022 or later and all delegation members (all players, coaches, team managers, physiotherapists, and Doctors) must also present the diploma issued after completing the FIVB anti-doping education program.

The organizer will provide on-court first aid treatment and transportation to the hospital. All other medical services should be paid by the rules of the Czech Medical Services by the teams or may only be covered by the IMSSA insurance company.

Since the competition is taking place in times of coronavirus pandemic, all participants will have to follow and respect the CEV Competitions Hygiene guidelines: https://inside.cev.eu/media/gdehzr1q/cev-competitions-hygiene-guidelines_final_18_11_2021.pdf as well as the Volleyball Specifications available here: https://inside.cev.eu/media/ej5ank5t/cev-hygiene-guidelines-volleyball-specifications-final-18_11_2021.pdf

12. Official Volleyball Rules and Balls

The competition shall be played with the FIVB Rules of the Game in force. MIKASA Ball Type V200W will be the only official ball used for this competition.

13. Player's uniform

The playing uniform must conform with the FIVB Rules of the Game. Each team must have available three sets of playing uniforms.



14. Transport

The official venue of arrival and departure for teams, officials, and referees is:

Prague – international airport – 140 km from Hradec Králové and 290 km from Prostějov

Czech Volleyball Federation allows the teams to arrive directly at Hradec Králové and Prostějov by their transportation.

15. Composition of the Delegations

Participating teams are permitted to have a team delegation composed of a maximum of 20 members and a maximum of 3 extra officials (totaling 23 persons) as follows: 10 to 14 players, 6 officials (including Team Manager, Head Coach, and either Medical Doctor with proof or Therapist with proof and accredited by CEV or FIVB to sit on the team bench).

In case of the absence of a Team delegation member, such an individual may be replaced but only by another individual assuming the same duties of the same role. If not replaced, the number of the Team delegation members is reduced accordingly.

Up to 3 extra team officials (e.g. an additional trainer/assistant coach/statistician, etc.) may be added to a team delegation, but they will only be accredited when their local travel, accommodation, and other necessary expenses are paid in advance by their National Federation to the organizing National Federation as the communicated extra team officials rate (see Art. 16).

16. Financial Conditions

The Czech Volleyball Federation will cover:

- Lodging and meals from arrival to departure of each delegation of 20 persons, CEV Jury Members, and International Referees.
- International transportation of the CEV Jury Members and International Referees
- Transportation from/to the airport and local transportation
- Medicare: to be assured by the Organizer
- Laundry of one set of players' uniforms (shirt short socks) per team and competition day.
- Per diem for the CEV Jury Members, SRC members, and International Referees <u>Each delegation will take care of the following expenses:</u>
- Contribution fee amounting to 70,- EUR per person for each member of its delegation (max. 21 persons)
- Own international travel expenses
- EUR 150,- per person per day for extra staying days or extra person (no more than three).

All fees are calculated and are to be paid in EUR – Euro – in cash on the day of arrival at the latest. Payment must reach the organizer's account no later than 6th July 2022 in the case of a bank order. Confirmation of the executed bank order has to be presented by the team during the Preliminary Inquiry. Differences, if any, have to be paid cash on the day of arrival.

The organizer will not accept travelers' checks and credit cards.



17. Meals

Meals will be arranged in compliance with CEV instructions: i.e. 3 meals (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner). During the days of the competition, the teams will be provided with a snack (i.e. sandwiches, drinks) before or after the match. Meals are scheduled according to the match and training schedule of the teams. During the matches and training sessions, the organizer will provide bottled water.

18. Laundry

The Organizers are bound to provide and bear the costs of laundry of the sports uniforms (1 set of playing uniforms and shorts) of the teams after each match.

19. Visa

Participants from certain European countries will have to apply for entry visas. They are requested to submit their application to the Czech Embassies in their country, respecting the deadline set by diplomatic consular authorities of the Government of the Czech Republic. Official invitations may be sent, if necessary, upon request.

20. Mixed Zone and Press Conference

The respective Team Managers should encourage their players to publish 'behind-the-scenes' content from the European Championship onto social and digital media along with the official competition hashtag #EuroVolleyU17W. Any such content should provide an insight into the team's participation in the championship, thus engaging fans following the competition remotely.
